	Term of the service related to payment account	Definition of the service related to payment account
1.	Account management	The account provider operates the account for use by the customer.
2.	Debit card issue	The account provider provides a payment card linked to the customer's account. The amount of each transaction made using the card is taken directly and in full from the customer's account.
3.	Credit card issue	The account provider provides a payment card linked to the customer's payment account. The total amount of the transactions made using the card during an agreed period is taken either in full or in part from the customer's payment account on an agreed date. A credit agreement between the provider and the customer determines whether interest will be charged to the customer for the borrowing.
4.	Cash withdrawal	The customer takes cash out of the customer's account.
5.	Cash depositing	Client deposits cash into his/her account.
6.	Credit transfer SEPA	The account provider instructed by the client transfers the money from the client's account into another account. Euros are transferred into the accounts opened in SEPA area countries.
7.	Credit transfer Not SEPA	The account provider instructed by the client transfers the money from the client's account into another account. Other than euros currency or into the accounts opened in the countries outside SEPA area is transferred.
8.	Direct debit	The customer permits someone else (recipient) to instruct the account provider to transfer money from the customer's account to that recipient. The account provider then transfers money to the recipient on a date or dates agreed by the customer and the recipient. The amount may vary.
9.	E- invoice	The account provider in accordance with the client's prior instruction pays the recipient's e-invoice submitted in the payer's Internet banking system.
10.	Crediting of received payments in EUR	The account provider credits into the client's account the payments in euros received from the accounts opened in the SEPA area countries.
11.	Crediting of received international payments	The account provider credits into the client's account the payments in other than euro currency or from the accounts opened in the countries outside the SEPA area.
